

## **Mounting instructions**

- **1.** Navigation lights should be vertically mounted. It should also be insured that, when in use, they are not being obstructed by superstructures, objects, or persons on board.
- 2. Boats over 12m in length, should have the masthead light mounted at least 2,5m above the gunwale.
- 3. It is possible that boats less than 12m in length have the masthead light mounted 1m (in height) above the side light.
- 4. When using a bicolour side light, this must be mounted lower than the masthead light, but not less than 1m (in height).
- **5.** Stern lights should be mounted above the keel line, at the stern if possible.










The following guide illustrates the required Navigation Lights per vessel's size according to regulations.





















\*Vessels less than 7 m with speed over than 7 knots need to have both All-around Light as well as Sidelights.
